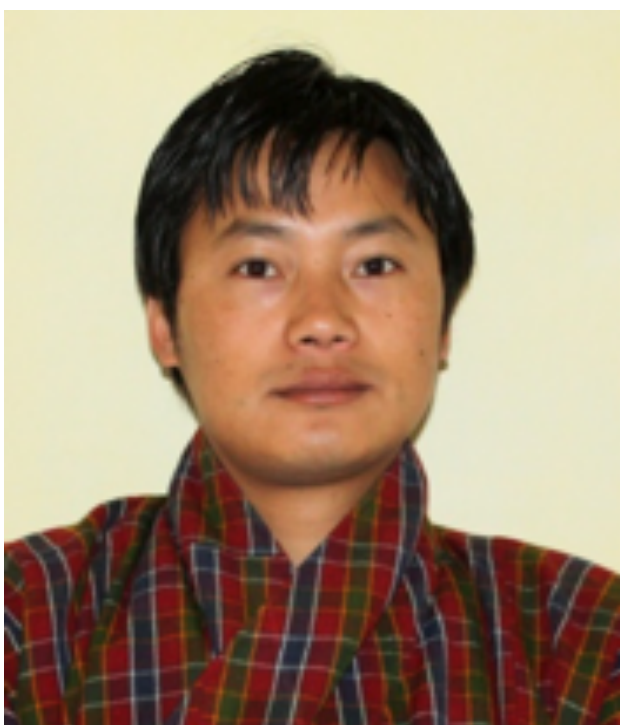




Thinley Gyeltshen
